Keynote Address—Preparing Leaders for the Mission Field of Secular, Multifaith Reality

200 years ago, missionaries left New England to bring the Gospel to countries where it had never been heard before. Now, one need not venture far to find communities that either do not know the Gospel or who celebrate faith in a way entirely different from the practices of Protestant Christianity. What does this mean for ministerial leadership formation, both in seminary and in churches that nurture lay and ordained leaders?

About Sarah Drummond:

Dr. Drummond joined the faculty of Andover Newton in 2005, coming from the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee, where she served as Protestant chaplain while pursuing a doctorate in educational administration. She previously served Harvard University as Assistant Dean of Freshmen as well as Chaplain for Religious Education at Memorial Church in Harvard Yard.

Dr. Drummond's research interests include leadership in theological education, ministerial formation, and institutional change. She teaches and consults in the area of program planning and evaluation for ministry and serves as an Evaluation Coach for campus religious organizations through the Evaluation Project at Valparaiso University.

She maintains a love for undergraduate campus religious life and serves Harvard University's chapel as an affiliated minister. She is ordained in the United Church of Christ and holds her ministerial standing in the Massachusetts Conference of the UCC.
